PTOE and PTP Certification Numbers Growing

PTOE and PTP Current Statistics

The number of certificants in both the Professional Traffic Operations Engineer® (PTOE) and Professional Transportation Planner® (PTP) certification programs continues to grow. Since the June 2013 exam, there are 167 new PTOE certificants and 33 new PTP certificants, for totals of 2734 and 339 certificants respectively. Application and renewal rates also continue to be strong. There have been over 3,700 applications to take the exam since the program began in 1999. The overall renewal rate for PTOE certifications is 92 percent and the renewal rate for PTP certifications is 83 percent.
